The slightly round lower shank measures 1.99mm wide at the base and 2.54mm wide at the shoulders. This item is assessed as mass production cast manufacture. Size L. 3.23 grams.

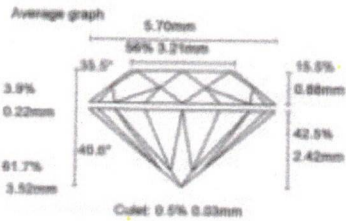

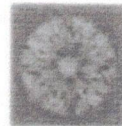

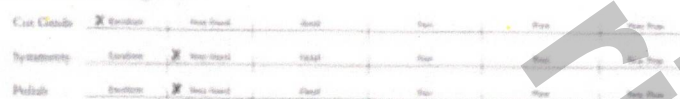
GIA Colour Grading Scale
