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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold and 18ct yellow gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, flat, tapered, band of 1.45mm width (at base) x 0.73mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrial.

Feature white gold round top plate within a twelve claw setting, housing one central round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one row of twelve single cut diamonds, bead set. The setting is secured to the underrial, and in between the extended and pointed shoulders, of the plain and polished yellow gold band.



Polished finish. Stamped '18CT' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: P 1/2.

The ring contains:

- One bead set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si1", colour is "I".
Dimensions = 3.90mm(Dia) x 2.38mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)
Total Weight = 0.22ct (estimated - see NOTE below)
- Twelve bead set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "I to J" (mixed).
Dimensions (average) = 1.40mm (diameter)
Total Weight = 0.14ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.09 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.36ct Total Metal Weight = 3.02 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
