Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct yellow and white gold, diamond set, solitaire ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures, 2.60mm width (at base) x 0.91mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "solitaire style" ring design. Comprising, a raised white gold four claw setting. Housing one round brilliant cut diamond (double laser inscription) & double certification, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the yellow gold band, tapers up to the top, base of the centre setting.



Polished finish, stamped "18ct partial" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Finger size = L.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "G", excellent cut quality.

Dimensions = 5.42 - 5.39mm (Diameter) x 3.34mm (D-estimated) x 3.5% (Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.60ct (actual - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.50 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.60ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.38 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The diamond has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Australian Diamond Grading Laboratory, Certificate no. Eternity A24841. Dated 22nd September 2011. & Messrs. Gemological Institute of America 1136740230. Dated August 26, 2011. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle partially hidden with claws A283231 & 1136740230. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retain insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
