Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.89mm width (at base) x 1.00mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature central square top plate, housing four round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. The top plate has a pierced decorative gallery, and is secured between the extended and pointed shoulders. Each of the shoulders has three round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size and channel set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.



Polished finish.

Stamped '9CT' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: M.

The ring contains:

Four bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.20mm(Dia) x 1.34mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.16ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Six channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.05mm(Dia) x 0.64mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.55mm(Dia) x 0.95mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.10 gram Total Gemstone Weight = 0.22ct Total Metal Weight = 2.06 grams (estimated)
