Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.71mm width (at base) x 1.02mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central eight claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one inner row of eight round brilliant cut diamonds, and one outer row of eight marquise shaped settings, each housing two single cut diamonds, and all bead set. The top plate is supported with a pierced decorative gallery and in between the 'split' and 'crossover' style shoulders, each set with eighteen single cut diamonds, bead set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.



Polished finish. Stamped 'NJ 9K.50' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: L.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 2.80mm(Dia) x 1.71mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.08ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eight bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.64mm(Dia) x 1.00mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.73mm(Dia) x 1.06mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.16ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Two bead set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & SI & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.00mm (diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.20mm (diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.36ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.07 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.60ct Total Metal Weight = 2.95 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
