Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone pendant, of cast construction.

Feature marquise shape pendant, one side having one row of of fourteen tapered baguette cut and baguette cut diamonds, channel set. The other side having one central row of twenty-four tapered baguette and baguette cut diamonds, and two outer rows, with a total of thirty-five single cut diamonds, claw set. There is a decorative open gallery in a 'scroll' design, and a hidden bail to the top of the pendant. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.



Pendant dimensions = 25.00mm (ave. length) x 13.00mm (ave. width) x 5.62mm (ave. depth).

Polished finish.

Stamped '9K' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

The pendant contains:

Thirty Five claw set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.00mm (diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.10mm (diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.21ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty Eight channel set tapered baguette cut and baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(L) x 0.80mm(W) x 0.58mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.70mm(L) x 1.00mm(W) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.38ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.79 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.59ct Total Metal Weight = 2.67 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar pendant employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only.
