Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.62mm width (at base) x 1.11mm depth.

Feature central three claw setting, housing one pear shape diamond, claw set. Surrounding is two rows of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the top of the band, and the gallery, shoulders, and underrail are embellished with diamonds, claw set. Inside the band, underneath the setting is one round sapphire, gypsy set. There are a total of seventythree round brilliant cut diamonds.



Polished finish.

Stamped '18K Sir michael hill 502162586 0.90' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: P 1/4.

One claw set pear shaped diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 6.94mm(L) x 4.24mm(W) x 2.89mm(D-estimated) x 3%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.53ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Seventy Three claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.90mm(Dia) x 0.55mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

One gypsy set round sapphire, colous is "pink".

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.01ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.56 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.91ct Total Metal Weight = 3.38 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by and is the opinion of Messrs. International Gemological Institute, Certificate no. 502162586 Dated December 1, 2021. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with IGI (logo) and 502162586 and Sir michael hill. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
