Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand crafted, 18ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring. Plain, narrow band of 2.19mm in width (at base) x 1.38mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature central four claw setting, housing one emerald cut diamond, claw set. Surrounded by sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. To either side is an extended plate having one baguette cut diamond, end set, with eight round brilliant cut diamonds (smallest), in a 'U' shape around, also claw set. The centre setting support of a four pierced 'leaf' design. All secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having three round brilliant cut diamonds (largest), claw set.



Polished finish - stamped 'RF 750 PT PD' - acid tested. Finger size is Q 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set emerald cut diamond, clarity 'Si1', colour 'D'.

Dimensions = 5.83mm(L) x 4.15mm(W) x 2.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.61ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Two end set baguette cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs', colour 'G to H' (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 3.00mm(L) x 1.80mm(W) x 1.20mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.17ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs & Si' (mixed), colour 'F/G'.

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.70mm(Dia) x 1.04mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.51ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.66 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 1.29ct - Total Metal Weight = 5.40 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The centre diamond has been certified by Messrs. Gemological Institute of America (GIA) laboratory Certificate number: 7246687839 Dated: January 19, 2017. The centre diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 7246687839. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
