Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand finished raised, platinum & diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.83mm width (at base) x 1.22mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "solitaire style" design, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to top. Houses one (laser inscribed) emerald cut diamond, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up to the top. Each shoulder contains five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, to both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "950" - acid tested as platinum. Finger size = I.

The ring contains;



One claw set emerald cut diamond (laser inscribed), clarity is "Si2", colour is "F", ex/vg cut quality.

Dimensions = 5.11mm (L) x 3.88mm (W) x 2.67mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (actual - see NOTE below).

Ten claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.70mm (average diameter) x 1.04mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.70 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.68ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.56 grams (estimated)

NOTE: No certificate was presented at the time of this valuation. However the emerald cut diamond, has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Gemological Institute of America, Certificate no.1348538909. Dated; January, 09, 2020. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 1348538909. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.

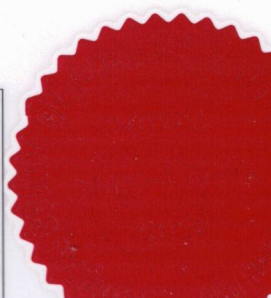

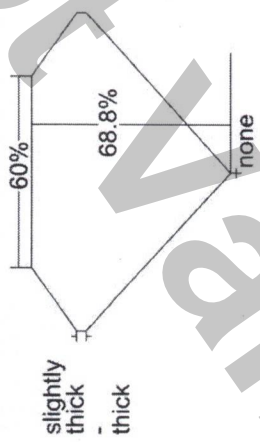

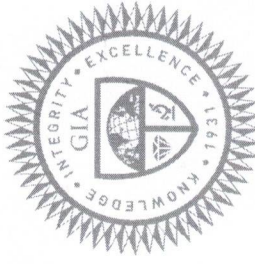
