Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand assembled 14ct white gold, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 14ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with a matching 14ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 4.05mm x 1.34mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The claws are created from the upswept 'split' style shoulders. The claws and the shoulders are bead set with diamonds. The matching wedding ring has three rows of diamonds, spanning across the top of the band, and bead set. There are a total of one hundred and fifty-five round brilliant cut diamonds. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish. Stamped '14K michael hill MHJ 1.14 44340600503' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: M.

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "F".

Dimensions = 5.47mm(L) x 5.44mm(W) x 3.58mm(D-estimated) x 5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.70ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

One Hundred And Fifty Five bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.02mm(Dia) x 0.62mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.17mm(Dia) x 0.71mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.01ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.89 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.71ct Total Metal Weight = 4.56 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by Messrs. Gemological Science International Certificate number: 44340600503 The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with michael hill and 44340600503. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
