

## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One lady's, handfinished raised 18ct white gold & gemstone set, multistone ring. Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band, measures 6.64mm width (at base) x 2.79mm depth, with curved underrail, openback settings, underneath. Comprising a clam style ring design, housing mixed gemstones, pave bead set (mixed). The extended shoulders, taper wide to the setting, from both sides. Polished finish, stamped "750" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = M.



The ring contains;

Eighty Eight pave set round natural rubies (some glass filled), colour is "dark - red".

Dimensions = 1.15mm (average diameter) x 0.70mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.35mm (average diameter) x 1.43mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 3.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

One Hundred And One pave set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "lite brown tint", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) x 0.73mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.50mm (average diameter) x 1.53mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 4.55ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twenty One bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.60mm (average diameter) x 0.98mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.50mm (average diameter) x 1.53mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.95ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twenty Three bead set round natural black star sapphire cabochons.

Dimensions = 2.80mm (average diameter-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.20mm (average diameter-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 3.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 26.81 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 11.60ct, Total Metal Weight = 24.49 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The Ruby's ID as natural however most if not all are possibly glass filled, & would require all unsetting for full gemmological testing, for verification. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
