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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 14ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring, of cast construction. Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.87mm in width (at base) x 1.18mm depth, with a curved and pierced underrail.

Feature central four claw setting, housing four trilliant cut diamonds, invisible set. Surrounded by sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds (largest), claw set. To either side is two baguette cut and tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, surrounded by seven round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size, all claw set. Secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having a double row design, each row with six round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size, claw set. Millegrain edging to the setting areas. Polished finish - unstamped - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Finger size is O.



### The ring contains:

Four invisible set trilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'I to J' (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.60mm(L) x 5.50mm(W) x 3.36mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.50mm(L) x 4.50mm(W) x 2.75mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.04ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four claw set baguette cut & tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, clarity 'V, Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'H to I' (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.60mm(L) x 1.60mm(W) x 1.17mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'I to J' (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.78ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.73 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 2.00ct - Total Metal Weight = 5.33 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
