## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, flexible link necklet, of hand-assembled construction.

Feature three open concentric circles pendant. The two inner circles are inside a clear chamber, and in the centre of all the circles is one bezel setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, bezel set. The two inner circles and the bezel setting are articulated, and move around within the chamber. The pendant is finished with a fixed round bail, to the top. The pendant is suspended on a 'trace' link style chain that is finished with a medium parrot clasp.

Chain dimensions = 50.00cm (ave. length) x 1.30mm (ave. width).

Pendant dimensions = 35.00mm (ave. length) x 21.90mm (ave. width) x 4.90mm (ave. depth).

Polished finish.

Stamped '750 18K unknown makers mark' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

The necket contains:

One bezel set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G". Dimensions = 3.15mm(Dia) x 1.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 19.56 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.12ct Total Metal Weight = 19.54 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstone cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the gemstone is very much an estimation. For an accurate weight, colour, and clarity grading, the gemstone requires removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar necklet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
