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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct yellow gold & diamond set, 2D - ribbon design brooch.

Feature "ornate 2D ribbon" design brooch, comprising, four rows (one over laps), housing thirty tapered baguette & baguette cut diamonds, channet set. Contains twenty one round briliant cut diamonds, tapering sizes, all bead set. Rhodium polished underneath to highlight, open back to settings. the brooch has a pin & roll-over catch closure fitted to back.

Polished finish, stamped "750" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Brooch dimensions = 29.00mm (total length) x 16.90mm (width) x 8.18mm (depth).

The brooch contains:

Thirty channel set tapered baguette cut & baguette cut diamonds (mixed), clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "G to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Average dimensions = 1.89mm (L) x 1.46mm (W) x 1.07mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Average dimensions = 2.93mm (L) x 1.99mm (W) x 1.45mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twenty One bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.41mm (average diameter) x 0.86mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.25mm (average diameter) x 1.37mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.13 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 2.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.73 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar brooch employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
