## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 14ct white gold and 14ct rose gold, gem set, 'cluster' style dress ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.52mm width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a cut out curved underrail.

Feature central rose gold three claw setting, housing one pear shaped natural morganite, claw set. Surrounding is one rose gold inner row, and one white gold outer row, of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with an open gallery, and is secured between the extended and square 'split' style shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders is embellished with 'strap' detail and one row of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. There are a total of eighty-seven round brilliant cut diamonds.



Polished finish. Stamped '14K CJ' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: T 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set pear shaped natural morganite, colour is "pink".

Dimensions = 11.97mm(L) x 7.99mm(W) x 4.84mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 2.27ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eighty Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.89mm(Dia) x 0.54mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.05mm(Dia) x 1.25mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.52ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.77 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 2.79ct

Total Metal Weight = 5.21 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
