Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, platinum, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, flat band of 2.02mm width (at base) x 1.28mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central round bezel setting, housing one round natural sapphire, bezel set. Surrounding is one row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The gallery has been embellished with two carre cut diamonds, and ten round brilliant cut diamonds, claw and bezel set. The top plate is secured between the upswept shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of six carre cut diamonds, bezel set.



Polished finish. Unstamped - acid tested as platinum. Ring size: K 1/2.

The ring contains:

One bezel set round natural sapphire, colour is "blue".

Dimensions = 7.30mm(Dia) x 4.37mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 1.68ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.95mm(Dia) x 0.58mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.21ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fourteen channel set carre (square) diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.70mm(L) x 1.70mm(W) x 1.21mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.42ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.77 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.31ct Total Metal Weight = 4.31 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, limited testing indicates that the corundum may be beryllium bulk diffusion treated. However, this can only be verified if the stone is removed from the setting and sent to a major laboratory for full chemical analysis which is the only way this type of treatment can be accurately identified. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
