Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct white gold, gem set, multistone ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.43mm width (at base) x 0.75mm depth.

Feature central five claw setting, housing one pear shaped fracture filled diamond, claw set. The setting is secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders house one row of six round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set.

Polished finish.

Stamped '585' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Ring size: N 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set pear shaped fracture filled diamond.

Dimensions = 9.03mm(L) x 5.76mm(W) x 3.95mm(D-estimated) x variable 1-3%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.24ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twelve claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.15mm(Dia) x 0.70mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.08ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.88 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.32ct Total Metal Weight = 1.62 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the centre fracture filled diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, the weight of the centre fracture filled diamond is very much an estimation. The centre fracture filled diamond has been enhanced by means of filling with a glass type substance. This treatment is not stable and can be damaged by heat or ultrasonic frequencies. Due to this filling, colour and clarity gradings have not been assigned. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
