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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, lady's 2pce set raised 9ct white gold & diamond set, multistone rings. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures a combined basal width 4.01mm width x 0.93mm depth, with curved underrails. Feature, 2pce ring set. Comprising, an engagement ring, cluster style with shoulder stones wrapping around centre, both sides. The side band a single channel set row, across the top of the band. The extended shoulders, of both bands taper up to the top, from both sides. Polished finish, stamped "375 JP88, 375 JP88" - acid tested both as 9 carat gold. Finger size = M1/2.



### ring set contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.00mm (Diameter) x 1.83mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.11ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Six claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "I to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.80mm (average diameter) x 1.10mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.00mm (average diameter) x 1.22mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Sixteen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "I to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.50mm (average diameter) x 0.92mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.80mm (average diameter) x 1.10mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.34ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirteen channel set baguette diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Average dimensions = 1.40mm (L) x 1.00mm (W) x 0.73mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 4.79 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.75ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.64 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar 2pce ring set, employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
