Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold, diamond set, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 9ct yellow gold and diamond set engagement ring with a fitted and matching 9ct yellow gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 4.41mm x 1.15mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a bezel setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, bezel set. The setting is secured in between the extended and pointed shoulders in a 'wrap around' style. Each of the shoulders houses four round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size and channel set.



The fitted and matching wedding ring, dips down into a point in the centre of the band. One of the pointed shoulders, houses eight round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish. Stamped '750 GM16' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: O 1/2.

The ring contains:

One bezel set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 3.80mm(Dia) x 2.32mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Seventeen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.70mm(Dia) x 1.04mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 7.00 gram Total Gemstone Weight = 0.40ct Total Metal Weight = 6.92 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
