## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, sterling silver, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 3.41mm width (at base) x 1.56mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central round top plate, housing six illusion settings, each housing one round brilliant cut diamonds, illusion set. Surrounding is one inner row of tapered baguette cut diamonds, channel set, and one outer row of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with an open wire base and in between the extended and square shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one inner row of tapered baguette cut diamonds, channel set, and two outer rows of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. There are a total of sixty-three round brilliant cut diamonds, and a total of fifty-six tapered baguette cut diamonds.

Polished finish. Stamped '925 1.00CT' - acid tested as sterling silver. Ring size: N.

The ring contains:

Sixty Three illusion and claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.00mm(Dia) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.45mm(Dia) x 0.88mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.60ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Six channel set tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.80mm(L) x 0.75mm(W) x 0.55mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.74 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 6.55 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
