Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, multi-stone, ring set, of hand assembled construction.

The set comprising a 18ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with matching 18ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 4.60mm x 1.48mm in depth. Both of the rings have open back (cut out) settings.

The engagement ring has a central end setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, end set. The setting is secured between the 'ramp'style shoulders. Each of the shoulder houses one row of four Princess cut diamonds, channel set. The shoulders extend out from the plain and polished band. The matching wedding ring has one row of nine Princess cut diamonds, spanning across the top of the band, channel set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish. Stamped '750 0.50' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: J 1/2.

The rings contain:

One end set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "I".

Dimensions = 4.24mm(L) x 4.07mm(W) x 3.20mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Seventeen channel set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.00mm(L) x 2.00mm(W) x 1.42mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.30mm(L) x 2.30mm(W) x 1.63mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.20 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.62ct Total Metal Weight = 8.88 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
