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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct white gold and 14ct rose gold, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.67mm width (at base) x 1.46mm depth, with a hollow top, open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature cushion shaped top plate, with a central four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is two rows of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the 'split' style shoulders, gallery and underrail, which are all embellished with round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, and two round rubies in a rose gold bezel setting, bezel set. There are a total of eighty round brilliant cut diamonds.

Polished finish. Stamped '14K Sir michael hill 50201900115 0.95' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: H.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 4.21mm(Dia) x 2.57mm(D-estimated) x 2.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eighty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.96mm(Dia) x 0.59mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.64mm(Dia) x 1mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.63ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two bezel set round rubies.

Dimensions (average) = 1.65mm(Dia) x 1.01mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.04ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.51 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.95ct Total Metal Weight = 4.32 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The inner band and girdle is inscribed with 'michael hill 50201900115'. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
