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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled raised, 18ct white gold & diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.10mm width (at base) x 1.05mm depth, with curved underrail, open back settings, at top, underneath.

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a navette shaped cluster to top, housing three round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set, to centre, drops to a surround, containing eighteen round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up to the top. Each shoulder contains four round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set, with a mill grain edge, to both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "750" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Finger size = K1/2.

The ring contains;

Three bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 2.50mm (average diameter) x 1.53mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 3.50mm (average diameter) x 2.14mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twenty Six bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) x 0.73mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.50mm (average diameter) x 0.92mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.26ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 4.59 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.54ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.48 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
