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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's hand-assembled raised, 18ct yellow and white gold, diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.88mm width (at base) x 1.41mm depth, with open back, underneath.

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with step down shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to centre, houses one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Drops to a cushion shaped surround in white gold, housing eight round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. To each sidesteps down three x four claw settings, in white gold containing three round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the yellow gold band tapers up, each shoulder terminates with an epaulette feature ontop.

Polished finish, stamped "18ct Pall" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Finger size = O1/2.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 4.02mm (average diameter) x 2.43mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.25ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Fourteen claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.90mm (average diameter) x 1.16mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 2.10mm (average diameter) x 1.28mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.45ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 5.25 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.70ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.12 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
