Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct rose gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.49mm width (at base) x 1.65mm depth.

Feature central six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one floating hexagonal row of twenty-four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of eight round brilliant cut diamond, claw set.

Polished finish.

Stamped '750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: K 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "F".

Dimensions = 5.71mm(L) x 5.70mm(W) x 3.55mm(D-estimated) x 4%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.71ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Forty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.10mm(Dia) x 0.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.18 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.03ct Total Metal Weight = 2.97 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by Messrs. Gemological Institute of America (GIA) Certificate number: 6165985758 Dated: March 10, 2014. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 6165985758. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
