Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand crafted, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring. Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.19mm in width (at base) x 0.95mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature white gold settings, consisting of a central semi-bezel setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, semi rub-over set. Surrounded by twelve single cut diamonds (largest), claw set. The setting is secured to the top of the yellow gold 'U' shape fitting, between the extended shoulders of the yellow gold plain and polished band. Each termination having white gold top plates, each claw set with three single cut diamonds (smallest), claw set.



Polished finish - stamped '18CT PALL BEV' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size is R.

The ring contains:

One semi bezel setting round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'P1', colour 'I',

Dimensions = 3.40mm(Dia) x 2.07mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.15ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eighteen claw set single cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs & Si' (mixed), colour 'G to H' (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.65mm(Dia) x 1.01mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.27ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 8.15 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.42ct - Total Metal Weight = 8.07 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
