Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct white gold & gemstone set, cluster ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.33mm width (at base) x 0.90mm depth, with curved underrail. Feature, "cluster style" ring design, Comprising, a raised four claw setting to centre, housing one round, faceted, sapphire (glass filled), claw set. drops to a suround, containing, eight round brilliant cut, diamonds, claw set. The lower surrouround, alternates four round brilliant cut diamonds, & eight bagutte cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up to pointed end terminations, to both sides. Polished finish, stamped "18K, 750, W" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger J.



The ring contains;

One claw set round sapphire, colour is "light pink (glass filled)".

Dimensions = 3.50mm (Diameter) x 2.14mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.20ct. (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twelve claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.80mm (average diameter) x 1.10mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.10mm (average diameter) x 1.89mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.90ct. (estimated - see NOTE below).

Eight claw set baguette diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Average dimensions = 3.50mm (L) x 1.80mm (W) x 1.31mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Average dimensions = 4.00mm (L) x 2.20mm (W) x 1.61mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.90ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.97 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 2.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 6.57 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The sapphire has been enhanced by means of filling with a glass type substance. This treatment is not stable and can be damaged by heat or ultrasonic frequencies. A treated sapphire of this type is not commercially available in Australia. Therefore, the below replacement figure is based upon procuring a similar treated sapphire from an overseas source. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
