Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 14ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring.

Plain, narrow, half round, tapered band of 2.00mm in width (at base) x 1.09mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature central four claw setting, consisting of a 'cluster' design, housing one round brilliant cut diamond to the centre, surrounded by nine round brilliant cut diamonds (smallest), claw set. Secured between the 'cross-over' style split shoulders. One side of each shoulder claw set with eight round brilliant cut diamonds (largest).



Polished finish - unstamped - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Finger size is K.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'Si2', colour 'G'.

Dimensions = 2.85mm(Dia) x 1.74mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.08ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Five claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'H to J' (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.36ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.09 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.44ct - Total Metal Weight = 3.00 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
