Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction. Plain, narrow, soft knife edge band 1.94mm width (at base) x 1.24mm depth, with open back settings, and supported with a curved underrail.

Feature one central raised four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounded by one row of sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The setting is secured between split shoulders. Each shoulder houses two rows of five round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size, claw set. One round brilliant cut diamond, three claw set in the middle of the split. The decorative gallery also houses eight round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size, claw set. Millegrain detail to all of the edging. Polished finish, stamped '18K 750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size: O 1/2.



The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 6.86mm(Dia) x 4.32mm(D-estimated) x 4%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.29ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Two claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G".

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.75mm(Dia) x 1.68mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.68ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.15mm(Dia) x 0.70mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.60 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.25ct Total Metal Weight = 6.16 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
