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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.62mm width (at base) x 0.74mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central railed white gold setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured to the underrail of the plain and polished yellow gold band. Each of the extended and pointed shoulders in a 'wrap around' style, house two round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.

Polished finish.

Stamped '750 S' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: K.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "SI", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 3.12mm(Dia) x 1.90mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.04ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.63 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.16ct Total Metal Weight = 1.60 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
