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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, multistone ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.70mm width (at base) x 1.65mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central eight claw decorative setting, housing one old cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured to the underrail and in between the extended and 'arrow' shaped shoulders. Each of the shoulders is supported with chenier detail, embellished with 'strap' detail, and two round natural sapphires, bead set.

Polished finish.

Stamped '18CT' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: J 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "I".

Dimensions = 4.16mm(L) x 4.15mm(W) x 1.93mm(D-estimated) x 1.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.21ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four claw set single cut round natural sapphires, colour is "blue".

Dimensions (average) = 1.63mm(Dia) x 0.99mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.07ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.07 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 0.28ct

Total Metal Weight = 3.01 grams (estimated)

NOTE: One of the central claws is broken. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
