Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow and white gold, multi-stone, ring set, of hand assembled construction.

The set comprising a 18ct yellow gold and white gold diamond set engagement ring with fitted and matching 18ct yellow and white gold diamond set wedding and eternity rings. Each ring having a plain, narrow, flat, tapered band with a combined basal width of 5.96mm x 0.78mm depth. The engagement ring has a white gold top plate, with a cental raised four claw setting, housing one oval corundum doublet, claw set. Surrounding is one row of ten round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate has an open wire base, and is secured between the extended and pointed shoulders of the yellow gold band.



The fitted and matching wedding and eternity rings are identical. There is one curved row of white gold four claw settings, each housing alternating round sapphires, and round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. There are a total of six sapphires, and four round brilliant cut diamonds. The settings are secured to the underrail, and in between the extended and pointed shoulders of the yellow gold band. The wedding and eternity rings sit alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish. Stamped '18CT HANDWROUGHT M PLAT 750 13261(engraved)' - acid tested and x-rayed. Ring size: Q. The ring contains:

One claw set oval shaped corundum doublet, colour is "blue".

Dimensions = $8.31 \text{mm}(L) \times 6.42 \text{mm}(W) \times 3.92 \text{mm}(D\text{-estimated})$

Total Weight = 1.70ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Six claw set round natural sapphires, colour is "blue".

Dimensions (average) = 2.33mm(Dia) x 1.42mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fourteen claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.30mm(Dia) x 1.40mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.50mm(Dia) x 1.53mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.70ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 10.86 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.70ct Total Metal Weight = 10.32 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
