## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 14ct white gold, diamond set, 'three stone' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.02mm width (at base) x 1.08mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature one central sweeping four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Either side of the central setting, is another sweeping four claw setting, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The settings are secured between the extended and pointed shoulders, of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish.

Stamped '14K michael hill 1.00' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Ring size: O.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "G"

Dimensions = 5.21mm(Dia) x 3.40mm(D-estimated) x 3.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.56ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 3.84mm(Dia) x 2.40mm(D-estimated) x 3%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.44ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.85 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 2.65 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
