Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 18ct white gold, multistone ring set.

The set comprising an 18ct white gold diamond set engagement ring, with a matching 18ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, tapered band with a combined basal width of 3.37mm x 1.07mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a six claw setting, consisting of a 'star' design illusion plate, housing one single cut diamond, illusion set. Secured between the extended shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having four single cut diamonds, channel set.



Matching wedding ring having twelve round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set across the top of the plain and polished band. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish - stamped '750 GM16' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size is N & O.

The ring contains:

Twenty One illusion set & channel set (mixed) round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs, Si & Pl' (mixed), colour 'H to J' (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.98mm(Dia) x 0.60mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.76mm(Dia) x 1.07mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.10 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.28ct

Total Metal Weight = 4.04 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
