## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and 9ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.78mm width (at base) x 1.09mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, an open back setting, and a curved underrail.

Feature central square white gold four claw setting, housing four Princess cut diamonds, invisibly set. The setting is secured between the upswept extended and pointed shoulders, of the plain and polished yellow gold band.

Polished finish.

Stamped '375 GM16' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: K.

The ring contains:

Four invisibly set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).  
Dimensions (average) = 2.00mm(L) x 2.00mm(W) x 1.42mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)  
Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.50 grams  
Total Gemstone Weight = 0.20ct  
Total Metal Weight = 1.46 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
