Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct \ low gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction

Plain, narrov, low half round band of 1.82mm width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with hollow top and shou 'ers, open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central raised square top plate, housing nine round brilliant cut diamonds, largest to the corners, claw set. Surrounding is one row of twenty-four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with a decorative pierced gallery. It is secured to the underrail and in between the extended and square shoulders. Each of the shoulders houses one row of seven round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.



Polished finish. Stamped '14K SKUSA' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: P.

The ring contains:

Four bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H".

Dimensions = 2.49mm(Dia) x 1.52mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.24ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Forty Three claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.90mm(Dia) x 0.55mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.49mm(Dia) x 0.91mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.39ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.95 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.63ct Total Metal Weight = 2.82 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
