Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

One, 18ct white gold, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 3.75mm width (at base) x 1.27mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail

Feature square top plate, with a central raised four claw setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, claw set. The surround, underrail and edges of the shoulders house a total of seventyeight round brilliant cut diamonds, varying in size, and bead set. The rail that runs under the central setting, houses one row of fifteen Princess cut diamonds, channel set. The top plate is secured to the upswept shoulders, of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish. Stamped '18K 750 unknown makers mark' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: L.

The ring contains:

One claw set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 4.60mm(L) x 4.49mm(W) x 3.19mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.47ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifteen channel set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G".

Dimensions (average) = 2.15mm(L) x 2.15mm(W) x 1.53mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.75ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Seventy Eight bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.82mm(Dia) x 1.11mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.51 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.50ct Total Metal Weight = 9.01 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
