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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's 2pce set, 14ct white gold & diamond set, multistone rings. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered bands, measure a combined basal width 3.29mm x 1.25mm depth, with curved underrails.

Feature, "2pce ring set". Comprising, a cluster engagement ring, with split end shoulders. Housing to centre one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Drops to a double square-shaped surround, containing thirty six round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders of the band, tapers up, splits to each side, contains eighteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. A contoured fitted side band, containing fifteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set in a single curved row across the top.



Polished finish, stamped "14k 0.92 michael hill, 14k 0.26 michael hill" - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Finger size J/J.5.

The ring set contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 4.30mm (diameter) x 2.60mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Twenty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.07mm (average diameter) x 0.65mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Forty Five claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.47mm (average diameter) x 0.90mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.80mm (average diameter) x 1.10mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.76ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 4.84 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.18ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.60 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar 2pce ring set, employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
