## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One 9ct yellow gold and 9ct white gold, gem set, multistone ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, wide flat, tapered band of 5.11mm width (at base) x 0.77mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature white gold rectangle top plate, housing four rows of seven round brilliant cut diamonds, varying slightly in size, and channel set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the tapering shoulders, of the plain and polished yellow gold band.

Polished finish.

Stamped '9ct JP146' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: W.



### The ring contains:

Twenty Eight bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.10mm(Dia) x 1.28mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.20mm(Dia) x 1.34mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 8.66 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct

Total Metal Weight = 8.46 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
