Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.79mm width (at base) x 1.46mm depth.

Feature central multi-claw setting, housing one oval shaped diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The gallery and shoulders are embellished with a total of fifty round brilliant diamonds, varyng in size, and claw set. Underneath the central setting is one round ruby, gypsy set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish. Stamped '18K 1.35 Sir Michael Hill 478108089' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: L 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set oval shaped diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 7.32mm(L) x 5.58mm(W) x 3.52mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.97ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Seventy claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.01mm(Dia) x 0.62mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.36mm(Dia) x 0.83mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.34ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

One gypsy set round ruby, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 2.01mm(Dia) x 1.23mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.04ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.84 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.35ct Total Metal Weight = 2.56 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been laser inscribed upon the star facet with IGI (logo) and 478108089. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
