Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 9ct white gold & diamond set, flexible link bracelet.

Feature, "curved ID bar to centre" housing eighteen round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set. To each side a bracelet of belcher style linked chain. Fitted with a parrot clasp closure to one side.

Polished finish, stamped "JP146 9CT" - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Bracelet dimensions = 20.00cm (total length inclusive) x 3.28mm - 3.74mm (width) x 1.85mm - 3.28mm (depth).

The bracelet contains:

Eighteen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "I to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.50mm (average diameter) x 0.92mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm (average diameter) x 0.98mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.27ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 5.80 grams. Total Gemstone Weight = 0.27ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.75 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar bracelet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
