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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand finished, raised 18ct white gold & diamond set, cluster dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.91mm width (at base) x 1.46mm depth, with open back, settings underneath.

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to centre top, houses one oval-shaped, faceted diamond (laser inscribed), claw set. Drops to a double surround, housing thirty four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up, Each shoulder contains eight round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "750" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = T.

The ring contains;

One claw set oval-shaped, faceted, diamond (laser inscribed), clarity is "Si1", colour is "E", very good cut quality.
Dimensions = 6.02mm (L) x 4.54mm (W) x 2.90mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.50ct (actual - see NOTE below).

Fifty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.43mm (average diameter) x 0.87mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.66mm (average diameter) x 1.01mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.60ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 5.00 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.10ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.78 grams (estimated)

NOTE: No certification was presented at the time of this valuation. However, the oval cut diamond, has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Gemological Institute of America, Certificate no.1243797051. Dated January, 27, 2017. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 1243797051. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
