Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand finished, raised, 10ct yellow gold & rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.65mm width (at base) x 1.42mm depth, with curved underrail, open back settings, underneath.

Feature, "single row" style, runs across the top. Comprising, six rub-over yellow gold settings with a white illusion inset, housing six round brilliant cut diamonds, illusion set. The extended shoulders, of the band, taper up to the top, from both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "10K michael hill 0.50TDW" - acid tested as approximately 10 carat gold.



Finger size = N1/2.

The ring contains;

Six illusion set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2& P3"(mixed), colour is "G/H"(inset), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.75mm (average diameter) x 1.74mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.78mm (average diameter) x 1.74mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.10 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.00 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
