Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct rose gold and 9ct white gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.33mm width (at base) x 1.21mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature white gold cushion shaped top plate, housing one central round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one inner row of alternating four large and and four small round brilliant cut diamonds, and one outer row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, all claw set. The top plate has a decorative pierced gallery, and is secured between the extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished rose gold band. Each of the shoulders, houses one row of six round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Rhodium plating to setting areas.



Polished finish. Stamped '375 P' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: K 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si1", colour is "I".

Dimensions = 3.33mm(Dia) x 2.03mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.14ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty Two bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.00mm(Dia) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.16ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.04 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct Total Metal Weight = 2.94 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
