## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, lady's hand crafted raised, 18ct yellow gold & gemset, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.78mm width (at base) x 1.08mm depth, with open back, underneath.

Feature, "trilogy filigree style", bridge design. Comprising to centre, one oval-shaped, faceted Synthetic ruby, cale set. Flanked to each side, one round faceted, natural ruby, claw set. Seperated by six single cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, tapers up to the top, pointed end terminations to both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "18ct" (engraved 2466) - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = M1/2.

The ring contains,

One claw set oval-shaped, faceted, synthetic ruby, colour is "dark red".

Dimensions = 8.41mm (L) x 6.97mm (W) x 4.03mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 1.91ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two claw set round natural rubies, colour is "dark red".

Dimensions = 4.83mm (average diameter) x 2.95mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.99ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Six claw set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "I to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.31mm (average diameter)

Total Weight = 0.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 5.97 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 2.96ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.38 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset, indicates the rubies are 1 x synthetic & 2 x natural, however, the natural rubies, 1 x appears heavily included, 1 x has a glass filling. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
