Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, 'solitaire' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.69mm width (at base) x 1.13mm depth, with an open back setting, and a curved underrail.

Feature central decorative 'knot' style six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured to the underrail and in between the extended and square shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish.

Stamped '750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: K.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Vs2", colour is "F" Dimensions = 4.99mm(L) x 4.96mm(W) x 3.26mm(D-estimated) x 3%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.50ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.92 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct Total Metal Weight = 1.82 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by and is the opinion of Messrs. International Gemological Institute, Certificate no. F4G50214 Dated June 19, 2014. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with IGI (logo) and F4G50214. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
