**Description:** An 18ct, stamped 750 JP88 white gold fourteen diamond ring. Diamonds are invisibly set in a square four claw collet setting. Diamonds are channel set in the slightly upraised shoulders. The slightly rounded band measures 2.7mm to 5.1mm in width. Cast manufacture. Ring Size: O.

4 x Diamonds – princess cut, 2.7mm x 2.7mm, estimated weight 0.11ct each, Clarity VS-SI, Colour J-K.

10 x Diamonds – princess cut, 2.1mm x 2.1mm x 1.4mm, estimated weight 0.05ct each, Clarity SI, Colour J-K.

Due to the stones being set the weight, clarity and colour are estimated.
