The shoulders are set with 8 natural brilliant cut diamonds 4 on each side of the centre diamond in a channel setting design. The setting has a height of 7mm & the shank has a width of 3.2mm. The centre diamond measures 3.8mm in diameter & has an approximate weight of 0.18carats. Total weight of 8 diamonds is approximately 0.16carats. Colour Grade: H Clarity Grade: SI1 The matching band is set with 10 natural brilliant cut diamonds in a channel setting design. Total weight of the 10 diamonds is approximately 0.15carats.
