## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One,14ct white gold, diamond set, multistone ring set, of cast construction. The set comprising a 14ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with a fitted 14ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, band with a combined basal width of 3.43mm x 1.46 mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a raised four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one inner row of fourteen round brilliant diamonds, claw set, and one outer row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The setting is secured between split shoulders, each housing fourteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The gallery is embellished with one row of thirty-two round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, that wraps around the entire setting. The fitted wedding ring is is set with one row of twenty round cut brillaint cut diamonds, claw set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish, stamped '585' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: N.

The rings contain:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 4.57mm(Dia) x 2.66mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

One Hundred And Fourteen claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.00mm(Dia) x 0.58mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 7.80 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.34ct Total Metal Weight = 7.53 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
