Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 18ct yellow gold, articulated, gem set bracelet.

Feature open back bezel settings, housing twelve glass filled natural rubies, thirteen natural blue sapphires, and twelve natural green sapphires, all tapering in size, rub-over set. The settings are articulated by the outer linkages, with ball design.

Small Asian 'S' style clasp fitted.

Polished finish - stamped '18K' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Bracelet dimensions = 19.00cm (length including clasp) x 8.43mm (ave. width).

The bracelet contains:

Thirty Seven rub over set mixed cut oval shaped corundum ie. 12 x glass filled natural rubies, 13 x blue sapphires, 12 x green sapphires, colour 'medium dark to dark' (mixed).

Dimensions = 4.23mm(L) x 3.27mm(W) x 2.05mm(D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 5.03mm(L) x 3.56mm(W) x 2.25mm(D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 10.73ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 10.27 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 10.73ct

Total Metal Weight = 8.12 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The rubies have been enhanced by means of filling with a glass type substance. This treatment is not stable and can be damaged by heat or ultrasonic frequencies. A treated ruby of this type is not commercially available in Australia. Therefore, the below replacement figure is based upon procuring similar treated rubies from an overseas source. This figure includes the currency conversion, import duty, and GST. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. Additional to the above ruby note, the below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar bracelet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
